Summer: Beans, Beets, Corn, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Garlic, Salad Greens, Herbs, Kale, Lettuce, Onions, Sweet and Hot Peppers, Potatoes, Summer Squash, Swiss Chard, Tomatoes, Watermelons



Fall: Beans, Beets, Bok Choi, Broccoli, Cabbage, Carrots, Cauliflower, Collard Greens, Herbs, Kale, Leeks, Lettuce, Parsnips, Peppers, Radishes, Spinach, Sweet Potatoes, Turnips, Winter Squash

Spoutwood Farm:

Located in Glen Rock, PA, Spoutwood is a 26-acre farm that lies 35 miles north of Baltimore and 15 miles south of York. Our 1.5 acre garden has been farmed without synthetic fertilizers or pesticides since the CSA began in 1996.



Community Supported Agriculture (CSA):

In the CSA model, shareholders commit to support a farm by paying in advance for a regular supply of vegetables. This allows the farmer to begin the season with the assurance that their products are already paid for. The commitment of shareholders to accept either surpluses or setbacks helps offset the unpredictability of the marketplace and weather.

We are Certified Naturally Grown meaning everything we grow at Spoutwood is produced without the use of synthetic chemicals. We are committed to the health of the land and of our community. By joining our CSA,



you can rest assured that your weekly harvest is safe, healthy, and delicious!

How It Works:

Each shareholder receives a **weekly delivery** of fresh, natural produce every **Thursday afternoon** for 24 weeks.

A **Large Share** is intended to meet most of the local produce needs for 3-4 people and costs \$695 - less than \$30 a week.

A **Medium Share** is intended for 1-2 people and costs \$475 - less than \$20 a week.

Working Shareholders have all the fun!

We encourage those with a flexible schedule and an energetic attitude to consider our working share option.



Working shareholders are involved in all aspects of the farm, from planting to harvesting. Physical labor in all types of weather is required.

A **Large Working Share** is available for just over 4 hours of work a week - 100 hours for the season.

A **Medium Working Share** is available for just under 3 hours of weekly work - 70 hours over the course of the season.
